

Virginia State University COVID-19 Update

- Vaccinating the VSU Campus Community began on April 1, 2021 for faculty and staff and April 17, 2021 for students.
- As of April 19, 2021, VSU has performed over 5,773 COVID-19 tests since January 15, 2021 recording a total of 82 positive cases and an overall test positivity rate of 1.4%.
- Last week we performed 431 tests and recorded 3 new campus related COVID-19 case plus 1 self-report which brought our active total to 5 and our weekly test positivity rate to .7%.
- > Two students isolated on campus and Three at their off-campus residence.




Virginia State University/Chesterfield Department of Health Planning and Assessment Team Meeting

- In continued efforts to maintain the health and safety of the faculty, staff and students on the VSU campus, the University continues to partner with the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) to identify potential areas for improvement.
- A state epidemiologist and her team visited campus on Thursday April 1, 2021 to make informed recommendations regarding containment, quarantine, and infection control guidance.







VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY RECEIVES "HIGH MARKS" FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

- Virginia State University is following guidelines appropriately, exercising proper measures, adjusting as needed, and is effective in following COVID-19 health and safety guidelines," says Nurse Epidemiologist Kyle Holmes.
- "Your handling of HVAC air quality is superior which is a key factor in lessening the potential of further spread of COVID-19." Holmes further commended VSU for its "excellent containment and prevention measures," saying VSU is "hitting the mark and doing very well."
- VDH recommendations for improvements at VSU were minor and centered primarily around additional signage in some buildings and bathrooms and additional student education efforts.
