Trojan Pathways: An AI-Integrated Faculty Toolkit for Individualized Student Learning at Virginia State University

Dr. James C. Fraser has been selected as the Teaching and Learning AI Fellow for the Thurgood Marshall AI Fellows Program. His project, Trojan Pathways: An AI-Integrated Faculty Toolkit for Individualized Student Learning at Virginia State University, will develop a faculty-facing toolkit that supports individualized learning, timely feedback, and AI literacy across the curriculum. Building on three years of AI-integrated course design, the toolkit will provide faculty with a Canvas-deployable module, AI literacy resources, adaptable assessment tools, and professional development workshops designed to enhance student learning and engagement. Through a cohort-based implementation model, Dr. Fraser will mentor faculty across multiple disciplines in adopting responsible and effective AI-supported teaching practices, positioning Virginia State University as a leader in evidence-based, AI-integrated instruction and faculty innovation
