What is Family Weekend?

Family Weekend is a time for families to connect with their student and the Trojan community. Parents, family members, students, faculty and staff are invited to participate in events and activities throughout the weekend. We welcome all students and anyone they consider as family to spend the weekend with us!

Is there a deadline to register?

We ask that family members planning to participate in Family Weekend register by Wednesday, September 14.

When should I plan to arrive?

Family Weekend events begin at noon on Friday and end on Sunday. Please review the schedule of events and plan to arrive based on your preference.

Am I allowed to attend class with my student on Friday?

We are thrilled that you are interested in your student's academic experience. However, logistically, VSU is not in the position to permit parents or family members to attend in-person classes due to our efforts to manage room capacities.

Please plan to attend the Academic Department Open House event scheduled for Friday.

Where can I find a schedule of events?

How much does it cost to attend?

Registration for Family Weekend is free. Due to limited capacity, each registered guest will receive (2) tickets to attend brunch in the campus dining halls (Gateway/Jones) on Saturday. Additional tickets are \$9 for purchase at the register in each dining hall. Brunch tickets are limited and will be distributed as guests arrive until capacity is reached.

Tickets to the football game are available for purchase online or at the VSU ticket box office. Fans are encouraged to wear orange to the football game.

Guests will also have the opportunity to purchase food at locally owned food trucks before, during and after the football game.

What are the Family Weekend Campus Bookstore hours?

Where can I park on campus?

Families may park in:

- Visitor spaces
- All Permit Lots
- General parking areas on Football Game Day

Parking is not permitted in:

- Handicap spaces (unless a valid permit is displayed)
- Reserved spaces
- Any space on campus that is not specifically designated for parking, such as campus roads, curbs, grass, building loading zones, walkways, roundabouts, etc.

Game Day Parking:

Game day parking at Roger Stadium is \$10 – card/credit only
