

2019 Winter Session Application



Deadline to submit Winter Session Application is December 5, 2019. (No application will be accepted after this date.)

Important Facts about Winter Session:

- For financial aid purposes, the winter session is an extension of the fall 2019 semester.
- Winter session financial aid is only available to students seeking a degree from Virginia State University. Due to the limited availability of financial aid, funding is not guaranteed.
- Student must complete the 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be considered for any winter session aid. Visit www.fafsa.gov – school code is 003764.
- Student must complete the 2019 winter session application on or before December 5, 2019.
- Student must be registered for classes to be considered for financial aid.
- If student has remaining eligibility from the current academic year, student may be allowed to use financial aid to pay for winter session.
- Pell Grant: eligible students enrolled in less than full-time for the fall semester and enrolled in winter session by fall census date (October 31st) will automatically be evaluated for potential Pell Grant eligibility.
- Federal Parent PLUS (dependent students only) – requires a minimum of 6 credit hours between the fall semester and winter session. Deadline to apply is December 5, 2019.
- Private/Alternative Loans must be approved and processed by December 5, 2019.
- Student must be eligible to receive financial aid based on Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
- SAP will be processed at the end of winter term for students enrolled; this may affect a student's spring 2020 financial aid status.
- Winter session awards will not be mailed. Students may access their award via Banner Self-service. Also, student should check their VSU email frequently for updates.

Student Affirmation:

I understand that submitting this application does not guarantee I will receive financial aid. I understand that my financial aid may be canceled or adjusted if federal, state and/or institutional regulations are not met.
