Off campus isolation refers to VSU students that have tested positive for COVID-19 and are isolating at home or the off campus location of their choosing. On campus isolation refers to VSU students that tested positive for COVID-19 and are isolating in designated facilities on VSU's campus. Total occupancy refers to the total number of beds VSU has designated for on campus isolation. Percent occupancy refers to the proportion of the isolation beds that are currently in use. This data will be updated weekly.



VSU's vaccination data comes from documentation submitted by students and employees to VSU's Health Services. Exemptions are UNVACCINATED individuals that have received either a medical or religious exemption. Non-compliant refers to UNVACCINATED individuals that have not submitted proof of vaccination AND do not have a medical or religious exemption. Vaccinated refers to individuals who have received at least one shot of a COVID-19 vaccine.

Residential students refers to all students that live in on-campus dormitories. All students refers to all students that come to campus, including both residential and commuter students. Employees refers to all faculty, staff, and administrators that work at VSU. Campus population refers to all faculty, staff, students, and administrators. It is the sum of the All students and Employees groups. This data will be updated weekly.
