All board members present certified compliance with the Freedom of Information Act.

On behalf of the Virginia State University Board of Visitors, Rector Black made the following statement:

First and foremost, the Board of Visitors extends our condolences to the family and friends of Eric Wilkins. The purpose of today's meeting was to allow the President and his staff to update the Board of Visitors on recent on- and off-campus incidents and their associated public safety ramifications.

President Miller has laid out a comprehensive framework through which to address these incidents, including, among other initiatives, engaging an external consultant to evaluate Virginia State University's policies and procedures as these relate to safety and security.

The Board fully supports the President's efforts to ensure that our campus continues to provide a safe living and learning environment. The safety and security of our students, faculty and staff is paramount.

We are proud of how our students, alumni and friends have come together during these past difficult days.

There being no further business, the Rector adjourned the meeting of the Board at 5:01 p.m.
