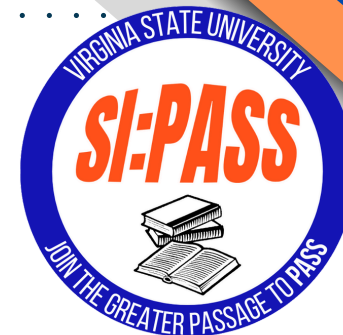
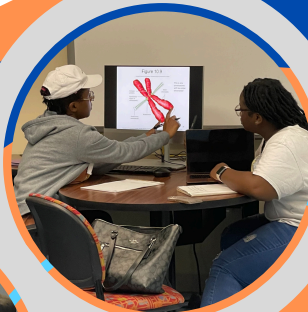
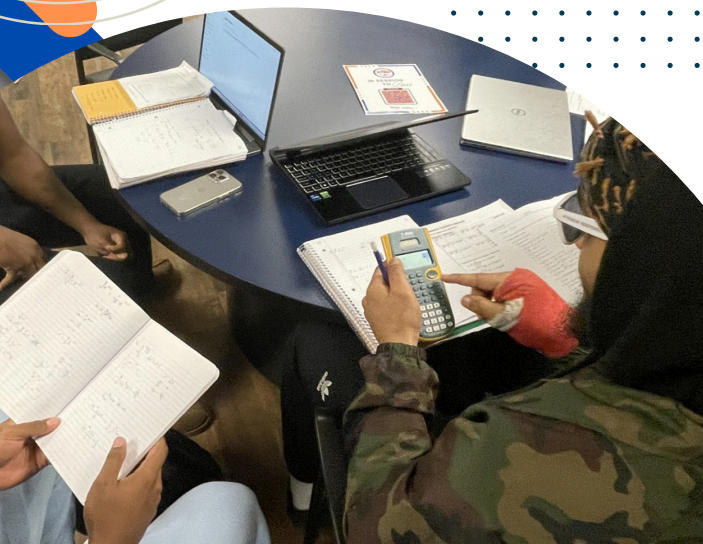

What is SI: PASS?

Supplemental Instruction (SI) is a powerful higher education tool utilized worldwide to support students in historically difficult courses. SI: PASS uses peer learning to increase student success and retention without tutoring or remediation; thus, Supplemental Instruction: Peer Assisted Study Session.

Faculty Benefits

- Enhance students' understanding of essential concepts.
- Receive feedback from students before the end-of-term evaluations.
- Improve interactions with students during class.
- Increase student retention, and course sequence continuance.
- SI: PASS faculty can work closely with and mentor high-achieving students.

SI: PASS Leaders

Duties: Leading out-of-class study sessions 2 times a week every week until the throughout the semester, while frequently attending and observing the class at hand. The SI: PASS leader sits in the classroom setting as if he/she is a student. In addition, the SI: PASS leader will have office hours and submit weekly lesson plans to prepare for the twice-a-week study sessions.

Benefits: Gain leadership skills, manage a study session, earn personalized recommendations, find more post-graduate study and employment opportunities, and stipends.

Requirements: We are looking for students who completed a challenging course and performed well. Exemplify excellent leadership abilities and interpersonal skills—a genuine interest in supporting students' success. Faculty may send a recommendation for a student to become an SI: PASS leader.
